- To coordinate and deliver quality Back to Netball programmes for women within designated areas of Coventry and Warwickshire.

## **Main Duties and Responsibilities**

- To deliver coaching sessions that are participant-centred, structured, progressive, fun and of high-quality to adults of all ages
- To take control of their own coaching timetable by booking programmes with facilities / clubs, organising promotional activities
- To undertake administrative tasks associated with the post, including planning sessions, taking registers, consent forms, contacting schools and collecting key performance indicators (KPIs)
- To undertake the necessary planning for each activity session to ensure the programme demonstrates progression throughout, linked to the principles of Long-term Athlete Development (LTAD)
- To continually monitor and evaluate all sessions, activities and programmes
- To adapt sessions to cater for different ranges of ability
- To be a positive role model at all times
- To ensure all equipment associated with the coaching programme is correctly set up, maintained, stored and returned on completion of the coaching programme
- To take responsibility for their own continuous professional development and attend relevant training courses to improve their coaching delivery
- To be familiar and comply with health and safety regulations for each location and to undertake activity/venue risk assessments prior to all sessions, and record and report incidents/accidents/hazards
- To adhere to sports coach UK's *Code of Practice for Sports Coaches*
- To respect the rights of all participants and ensure that their well-being and safety is considered at all times
